A Guide to Caravan & Camping in Moreton Bay Region

With its wide-open spaces, mountains, creeks, bays and beaches, Moreton Bay Region has a diversity of camping options to suit the outdoors and nature lovers. Whether you rough it in a swag or glamp in an RV, enjoy a spot of fishing or like an off-road 4WD adventure, Moreton Bay has it covered.



1. Bellara Caravan Park

1-7 Eucalypt Street, Bellara 4507

Dreaming of hot summer days and lazy afternoons? Unwind and reset to island time with a getaway at Bellara Caravan Park. There are over 80 powered sites, BBQ and picnic facilities, toilet & show block amenities, plus onsite management.



2. Archer Campgrounds Rasmussen Road, Mount Archer 4514

A hidden gem of the Moreton Bay Region, Archer Campgrounds is an open camping area, well grassed and shaded by bog old gums. These campgrounds are tent and ute slider only (sorry no caravans permitted). Facilities include one car park and fire pit per campsite, toilets, and tap water (not for drinking).



3. Bongaree Caravan Park 25-47 Welsby Parade, Bongaree

4507

This large, tidy council-operated caravan park is situated right near the mouth of Pumicestone Passage, and close to local shops, restaurants and cafes. There are waterfront, powered sites, cottages and cabins available. Facilities include toilets, showers, laundry, BBQ area and general store.



4. Neurum Creek **Campgrounds**

Neurum Creek Road, Stony Creek 4514

Nestled in eucalypt woodland, Neurum Creek Camping grounds is located on the eastern side of Mount Mee in D'Aguilar National Park. Access to campgrounds is best suited to an off-road vehicle with RV's and camper trailers prohibited. Facilities include toilet water (not for drinking).



5. Scarborough Village **Holiday Park**

Reef Point Esplanade, Scarborough 4020

This modern and well-kept caravan park, situated by Scarborough Marina, offers all the modern facilities you need. Villas and caravan sites available. Facilities include shower, laundry, toilets, BBQ, recreational facilities, café/coffee shop and large grassed play area.



6. Running Creek Parklands Nonmus Road, Stanmore 4514

Running Creek Parklands is a petfriendly camping area located in the North of Moreton Bay Region. There are several campsites available with animal feeding sessions and generator use allowed. Facilities include portable toilets and showers, and fire drums. Note: no taps onsite.



7. Donnybrook Caravan Park 17-19 Alice Street, Donnybrook

4510

This waterside caravanning and camping spot in the peaceful seaside Donnybrook community is located next door to the Donnybrook boat ramp, and overlooks Pumicestone Passage with views across to Bribie Island. There are 12 caravan sites and 6 tent sites available (powered and unpowered). Facilities include toilers, showers, BBQ area, laundry, adjacent boat ramp.



8. Ocean Beach Camping Bribie Island National Park

The largest and most popular camping area on Bribie Island, Ocean Beach Campgrounds has 63 numbered sites accessed by four-wheel drive only. Located in the Bribie Island National Park, just in from the shoreline of Woorim's popular four-wheel drive beach, Ocean Beach Camping Area sites are just behind the dunes with clearly defined track entrances. Camping permits are required, and fees apply. A tag with your booking number must be displayed at your camp site.



9. Beachmere Caravan Park Biggs Avenue, Beachmere 4510

Beachmere Caravan Park is situated in an ideal spot, in close walking proximity to the beach, local bowling club, parks, cafes and restaurants, and a 20 - 30 minute drive from Bribie Island and Caboolture, 24 powered sites and 4 unpowered sites available. Facilities include toilets, showers, camp kitchen, laundry.



10. Northbrook Mountain Bush Camp

England Creek Road, Wivenhoe Outlook

This walk-in campsite overlooks Kipper Creek and the beautiful subtropical forest and is a great spot to enjoy some peace and quiet at a walk-in bush camp near Brisbane. From the campsite, it's a short 10 to 15-minute walk to the Northbrook Mountain summit, where you can catch an amazing sunrise and beautiful southerly views. Note: campsite is walk-in only meaning that everything must be brought with you.


